Mike Kileen

Mike Kileen, a native son of Bakersfield, recently retired after 34 years of service to local school districts and was the Assistant Superintendent of Business Services for Panama-Buena Vista Union School District. He has held many positions on the Board, including Chairman of the Board, during his 32 years as a KSFCU Director. Mike has also been active in local, state, and national educational and technology organizations. He currently serves as Chairman of the KSFCU Member Education Committee and is President of the Bakersfield Christmas Parade Board of Directors.

Tom Ross

Tom Ross has been the Director of Purchasing for the Bakersfield City School District for 24 years. Tom has served as a Board Member for Self Insured Schools of California for 20 years as a representative for the Bakersfield City School District. He has also served on Kern Schools Federal Credit Union's Supervisory Committee for over 3 years reviewing audits and providing general oversight of the Board's actions.

Dr. Larry Reider

Dr. Larry Reider spent 44 years in Kern County's public education system as a teacher, principal, school district superintendent, and retired after 10 years as Kern County Superintendent of Schools in 2009.
